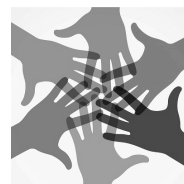

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October is the Month of the Holy Rosary, a reminder for us especially as Catholics to pray the Rosary every day for peace in our world, in our homes and in our hearts.

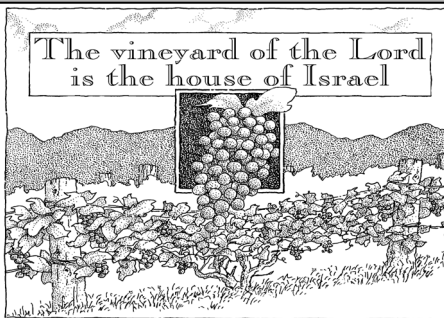

Respecting life means respecting life in all its forms and stages. For all its complexity, for all its complication, for all its sorrows and fears, for all its headaches and heartaches, for all its inconvenience - life – every life at every moment – still matters... because it is of God.

BEARING THE RIGHT KIND OF FRUIT



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Today's readings focus our attention on vineyards. Isaiah's song concerning his friend's vineyard begins with inspiring and poetic images of

an idyllic vineyard where the choicest harvest is expected. Instead, the vineyard yields wild grapes, which causes the owner to abandon it. The psalmist cries out to God, asking that God once again take care of the vineyard, which is the house of Israel. The parable told in today's Gospel offers a stern warning that those who commit treachery in the hopes of attaining personal wealth will be "put . . . to a wretched death" (Matthew 21:41). Jesus warns his listeners not to act like the murderous tenants in the vineyard. Instead he exhorts them to produce the kind of fruit that will lead them to the kingdom of God.

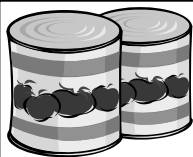
Our Lady of the Rosary

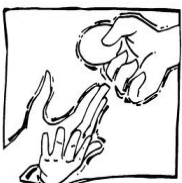

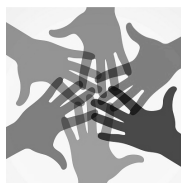
