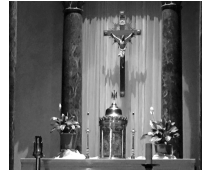

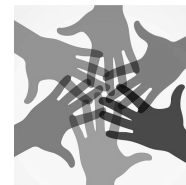

Sus sacrificios durante tantas décadas dejan ahora a sus comunidades religiosas con un gran déficit en los fondos para su jubilación. La expectativa de vidas más largas y el aumento en el costo del cuidado de la salud agravan el reto de proporcionar cuidado adecuado.

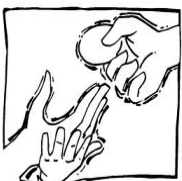

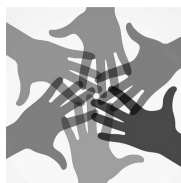
