Please stop by at the office to register at least three (3) months prior. A baptismal preparation is offered to help parents and godparents understand more deeply the sacrament.



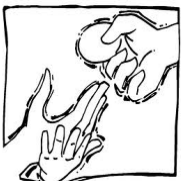
Getting married in the Church?

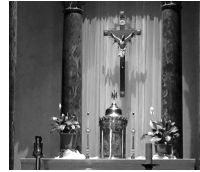

In light of our preparation to organize our efforts for the building of our new Church, we need to get some statistics. Currently we have 882 families registered, 320 families use envelopes to share the stewardship of their treasure either weekly or monthly; but in reality we serve close to 3000 families. Thanksgiving Faith Family Feast

We are looking forward to spending a few days off with our families and friends over the Thanksgiving Holidays but we are blessed to be able to share a feast with our Faith Families before we leave for the holiday. HRS school Faith Families are a long standing tradition where eighth graders are considered parents and a student from each grade level is in their family. Faculty and staff play the supporting role of God Parents to a family or two.

Holy Rosary School Angels

We at Holy Rosary Parish are all called to support the rich tradition of Catholic education. For the past three years, the **Holy Rosary School Angels** program has helped numerous Catholic families reduce their tuition thus making Catholic education more affordable and accessible. SERVING JESUS IN THE HOMELESS (WOODLAND SHELTER - YEAR 3)

The annual Woodland Shelter aims to assist Fourth & Hope by providing additional housing for homeless families and women during the winter, providing a safe and warm place to sleep. Volunteers are essential to the program and there are many opportunities for participation. Just a few hours of your time can make a big difference for the local homeless community.

Some churches from WEMM have been part of this effort, and we are extending the invitation to Holy Rosary parishioners to serve Jesus in the homeless.

Dates: Nightly from January 6th through March 3, 2019.

Location: St Luke's Episcopal Church, 515 Second St.

The program will take place at St Luke's for all '8' weeks, but is being hosted by various churches each week. Participants can sign up for any day they are available. A Fourth & Hope employee will be present at all shifts.

Types of Shifts include:

- ◆ Morning/evening driving—transport participants between Fourth & Hope and St Luke's
- ◆ Evening monitors—check in participants, interact with participants, set out snacks
- ◆ Overnight Monitors (*volunteers can sleep*) - assist Fourth and Hope employee if needed, assist getting participants ready to go in the morning
- ◆ Weekly shifts: activity hosts, snacks, cleaning, laundering sleeping bags

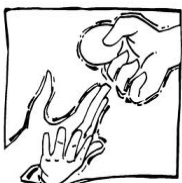

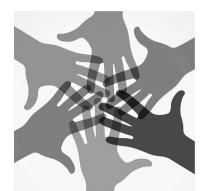
