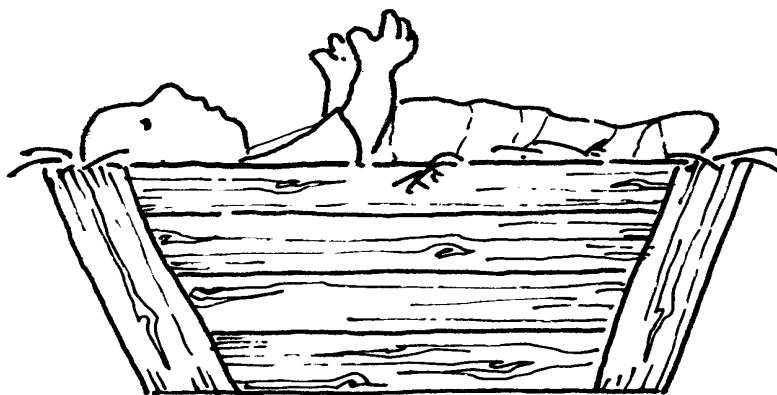

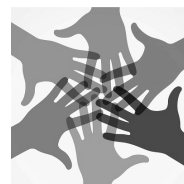

¿Por qué pasa esto? Si vemos las historias en la Biblia, Dios siempre se ha relacionado él mismo con los pobres, con los insignificantes. Y su poder siempre se ha manifestado mayor en la impotencia de los indefensos. María nuestra Madre se apareció a Bernardita, Lucia, Francisco, Jacinta y Juan Diego no simplemente porque eran unos 'don nadie' sino por su sencillez, humildad y fe en sus corazones.

¡Que estemos consientes más y más de nuestra 'insignificancia' ante el Señor y luchemos por ser más sencillos, humildes y tener fe en nuestros corazones!

FROM FR. JONATHAN

This past week, we celebrated the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe and this year, we commemorated the 100th anniversary of Fatima.

One underlying reality of the approved apparitions of Mary is that she chose to appear to **ordinary people**. In Lourdes, she appeared to a simple village girl, Bernadette. In Fatima, she appeared to the three innocent young children, Lucia, Francisco and Jacinta. And in Mexico, she appeared to Juan Diego, a peasant. Mary has never, it seems, appeared to a president of a nation or a Wall Street banker or even a theologian in his study.

Why is this? If we look at the stories in the Bible, God has always sided himself with the poor, with the nobodies. And His power has always shone more powerfully in the powerlessness of the powerless. Mother Mary appeared to Bernadette, Lucia, Francisco and Jacinta, Juan Diego not simply because they were nobodies but also because of the simplicity, humility and faith in their hearts.

May we realize more and more of our 'nothingness' before the Lord and strive for more simplicity, humility and faith in our hearts!

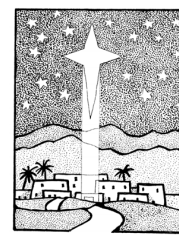

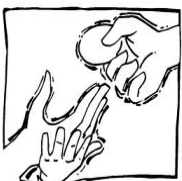

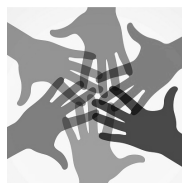
