Please stop by at the office to register at least three (3) months prior. A baptismal preparation is offered to help parents and godparents understand more deeply the sacrament.



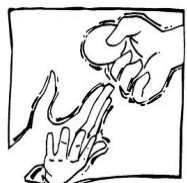
Getting married in the Church?

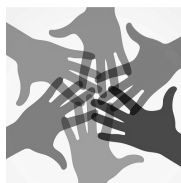

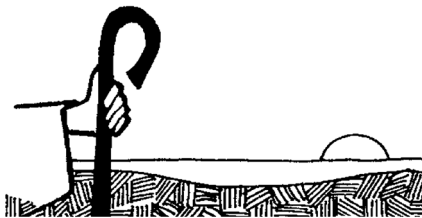
