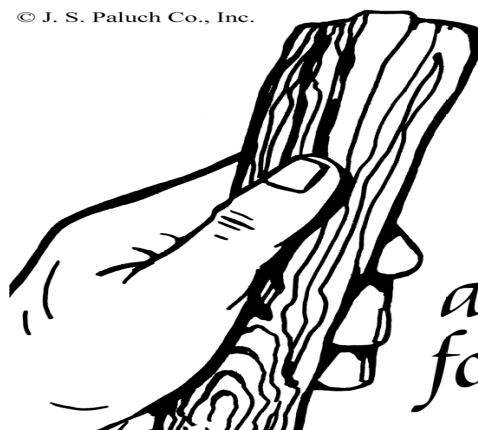

Please stop by at the office to register at least three (3) months prior. A baptismal preparation is offered to help parents and godparents understand more deeply the sacrament.



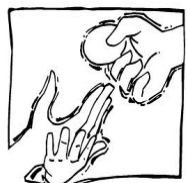
Getting married in the Church?

On this Fourth Sunday of Easter a.k.a. Good Shepherd Sunday, I share with you a reflection from Fr. Henri Nouwen entitled, "Loving Our Religious Leaders".

Religious leaders (like priests) can be admired and revered but also hated and despised. We expect that our religious leaders will bring us closer to God through their prayers, teaching, and guidance. Therefore, we watch their behavior carefully and listen critically to their words. But precisely because we expect them, often without fully realizing it, to be superhuman, we are easily disappointed or even feel betrayed when they prove to be just as human as we are. Thus, our unmitigated admiration quickly turns into unrestrained anger.

Let's try to love our religious leaders, forgive them their faults, and see them as brothers and sisters. Then we will enable them, in their brokenness, to lead us closer to the heart of God.

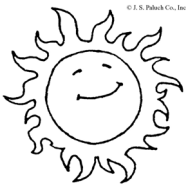
Transitional Kindergarten -Now Enrolling

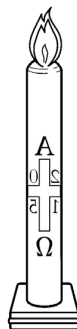
Retiro de Eucaristía—obligatorio

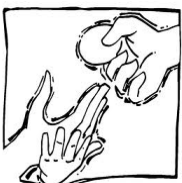

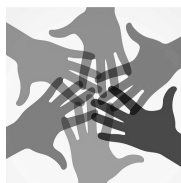

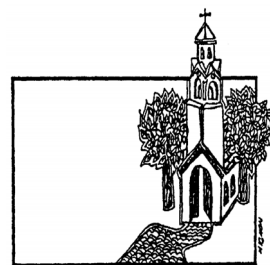
