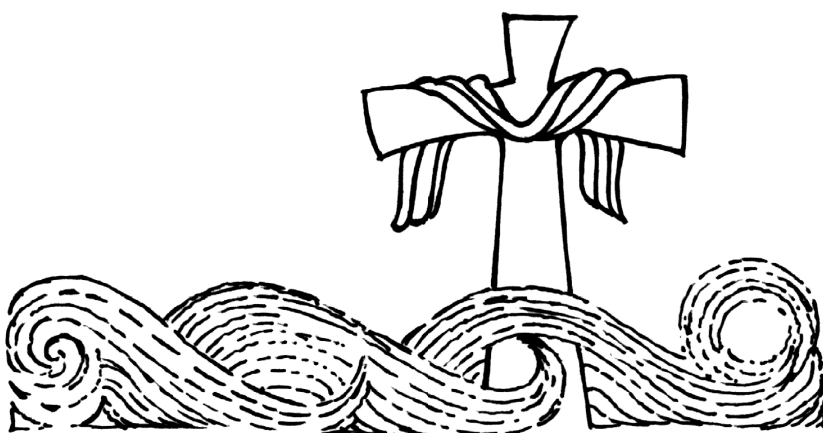

Please stop by at the office to register at least three (3) months prior. A baptismal preparation is offered to help parents and godparents understand more deeply the sacrament.



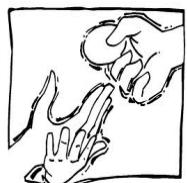
Getting married in the Church?

Here's a story you may have heard or read before – a good repeat.

A young man prayed one night, “Lord, how can I love you more? How can I serve you more? On that same night the Lord revealed himself and said, “Yes, I have work for you to do. There is a huge rock in front of your cabin and I want you to push against that rock every single day.” For days, weeks, months, years, the young man did as he was told; he pushed against that rock. Yet every night he would return to his cabin worn out, feeling that his efforts were worthless. “There is no way you can move that rock. It's impossible!” he would hear the devil telling him. But, instead of listening to the devil, the man would take his troubles to the Lord and say, “Lord, I have worked long and hard, putting all my strength on the task you gave me. Yet, I feel I am a failure, I haven't even budged that rock. What is wrong, Lord?” **And the Lord said to him**, “My son, there is nothing wrong. When I gave you that task, I told you to push - with all your strength - which you have done most faithfully. Never once did I mention that you would move it. And now you come to me with your strength spent, thinking that you have failed... but look, look at yourself - your arms are strong and your legs have become sturdy. 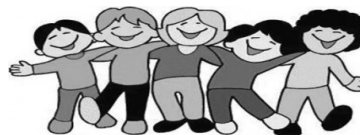

FROM FR. JONATHAN

Mary and Martha - two beautiful sisters, two good friends of Jesus, two sisters who have represented the two spiritualities in the Christian faith, the active and contemplative. Mary, sitting by the feet of Jesus, as the contemplative one and Martha, firing up the grill, as the active one. These descriptions have been used to compare Pope Benedict and Pope Francis as well. Pope Benedict as the contemplative one and Pope Francis as the active one, or as a writer puts it, "Pope Benedict as a classical music and Pope Francis as a folk music - two different types of music, yet two beautiful kinds of music."

One thing we have to remember – yes, Mary and Martha are different, Pope Benedict and Pope Francis are different - but not one is better than the other, not one spirituality is to be preferred over the other. In fact, both spiritualities are essential in the life of the Church and in the life of any Christian. The message for us is to have both spiritualities, to find balance between contemplation and action. Action without contemplation is empty. Contemplation without action is dead. Prayer and worship and works of mercy and love always go together. There has to be always that balance in our life which has as its foundation, the source of all spiritualities, God.

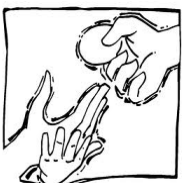

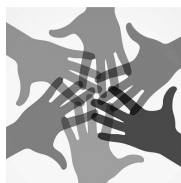
